



## Kenya Thiririka Cooperative

- REGION: Kiambu
- GROWER: Thiririka
- PROCESSING: Fully washed
- GROWING ALTITUDE: 1600-1800 masl
- PLANT VARIETIES/CULTIVAR: SL 28, SL 34, Batian
- HARVEST PERIOD: October - December
- CERTIFICATIONS: Conventional

This coffee is produced in south-central Kenya, in Kiambu County. This county (just north of Nairobi) lies east of the Great Rift Valley at the foothills of the Aberdare Range. Given the terrain, most of Kiambu is comprised of highlands with rich soils and dependable rainfall.

It is the product of the Thiririka Farmer Cooperative Society, a collection of approximately 400 active farmers producing roughly 450 bags per year and comprised of three factories: Githembe, Kiganjo, and Ndundu. The Cooperative is under new management, namely by Chief Executive Officer Joyce Kariri. Githembe factory (built in 1969) is also benefiting from women's leadership under the management of Joyce Wanjiku.
